**Item No.21.07:** To consider and approve the Annual Accounts for the Financial year 2019-20.

The agenda was approved as proposed.

**Item No.21.08:** To note the expenditure of the Institute as on 25<sup>th</sup> November 2020.

The expenditure incurred by the Institute were noted and the members advised to ensure compliance with GFR-17.

**Item No.21.09:** To discuss and deliberate on the difficulties faced by the Institute due to non-availability of adequate number of sanctioned teaching and non-teaching positions

The BOG was apprised of difficulties faced by the Institute due to non-availability of adequate number of sanctioned teaching and non-teaching positions. Chairman informed the members that total sanctioned intake considering all UG & PG programs of the Institute is 960, and therefore, considering the students-faculty ratio of 12:1 prescribed by MoE, number of faculty posts required is eighty (80). However, the sanctioned faculty strength is only 38. The students-faculty ratio at the Institute is 37:1, which is not reflective of an Institute of National Importance. He further added that inadequate number of sanctioned faculty positions is one of the main reasons behind the dismal ranking of the Institute in NIRF-2020. Moreover, due to the shortage of faculty, the Institute is yet to initiate the accreditation process as per NBA and real attainment of NEP-2020 objectives. Mrs. Darshana M. Dabral, Joint Secretary, FA, MHRD, GOI informed the board that the process for sanctioning faculty in NITs has been initiated at the Ministry. The members requested to expedite the sanction of additional faculty positions for the Institute.

**Item No.21.10:** To report the nomination of Dr. Dhananjay Tripathi as a member on the BoG of the Institute as approved by the Senate in its 13<sup>th</sup> Meeting.

The members noted the minutes of the BWC and advised to follow the GFR and BoG directions.


**Item No.20.16: To report the Minutes of the 15<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Finance Committee.**

**Item No.20.17: To report the successful organization of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Convocation.**

Chairman informed the members about successful organization of 3<sup>rd</sup> convocation of NIT Sikkim on 7<sup>th</sup> December 2020. A total of 242 students who had graduated in the years 2018 and 2019 were awarded the degrees. It included 187 students of Bachelor of Technology, 37 students of Master of Technology, 15 students of Master of Science and 3 students of Doctor of Philosophy. The meritorious students from each discipline were awarded Gold Medals. The Best Student of the batch was awarded with Director Gold Medal and Institute Gold Medal. Total 21 Gold Medals were awarded in this convocation.

Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Governor of Sikkim, Shri Ganga Prasad, Hon'ble Minister of Education, Shri Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank', Hon'ble Chief Minister of the State of Sikkim, Shri Prem Singh Tamang, and Hon'ble Minister of State in the Ministries of Education, Communications and Electronics & Information Technology, Govt. of India, Shri Sanjay Dhotre sent heartwarming messages congratulating the students for their academic accomplishments and urged them to work towards the realization of 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat'.
