Item No.37.01: To consider and approve the Audited Annual Accounts and Separate Audit Report for the FY 2022-23.

It was instructed that the reconciliation of accounts regarding the construction works at the temporary campus which is long pending with the CPWD should be done on priority to prevent future audit paras. It was also suggested that for any kind of advice required on financial matters, a consultant may be hired instead of taking advice from the Internal Auditors to avoid any conflict of interest.

The Chairman enquired on various aspects of the Annual Accounts such as change in the expenditure and income levels vis-à-vis the previous financial year. The Institute authorities provided detailed comments on the queries on the annual accounts.

The BoG approved the Audited Annual Accounts and the SAR for the Financial Year 2022-23.
