The Chairman welcomed the members and thanked them for taking time out to attend the meeting.

Item No. 1.01: To report the works completed by CPWD

The Committee noted and ratified the completed status till date of the civil works by CPWD. Further the urgency of large construction works in light of uncertainty in possible land handover for permanent campus is noted and in-principle approvals are given.

	Hostel (Phase I) The BWC noted on account of update from CPWD, handover after completion is expected by April-end, 2015. It is also recommended that Electrical connections to pre-fab Hostel rooms to be done by bulletSockets to avoid loose-connection	
	Hostel (Phase II) The BWC expressed to CPWD members to speed-up for works to accommodate new student intake and approved for partial fund release.	
3	Prefab Kitchen cum mess CPWD is requested for completion as soon as possible.	
	HPC room On account of adjacent ICT and sitting room, which wass added later in the scope. The revised estimate with an additional fund of Rs. 578625 is approved	
5	Roof treatment of existing buildings The committee noted the completion status as updated by CPWD.	
6	Conference cum pantry in admin block The adjacent vacant space is recommended by the BWC to be utilized by covering with transparent fibre sheet with roof truss.	
7	Maintenance of water tank for existing apartments: cleaning, external pipe connection and miscellaneous	

The BWC noted that damaged water tanks are replaced and pipe connections are elevated for better distribution.

Playground, Workshop block (shed I) and Laboratory complex (shed II & III) along with required electrical installations

The BWC approved for revision in floor-plan for better space utilisation. The laboratory shed is recommended for elevated story height to accommodate larger instruments. The remaining part is recommended for two-story construction to better utilize the space.

Auxiliary mess near Hostel (Phase I)

The committee noted the progress and approved for partial fund release.

13.

Electrical works

The BWCapproved the proposal of providing and installation of 2 Nos.High Mast Light. I No. 5 kVA UPS. I No. 2 kVA UPS. Generator line connection to Laboratories and boys mess with budget estimate of Rs 19,90155 and Secondary switching lever jammed on Transformer, etc. with budget estimate of Rs1,78500. Further it was also approved to procure another generator set to address increasing demand and for redundancy.

The BWC also noted the proposals for Earthing and wiring concerning boys Hostels. Faculty buildings etc., Service of Generator, maintenance requisition for which is to be requested from CPWD.

Item No. 1.03: To re-consider the proposals for water reservoir and road to hostel (phase I)

Noting the water supply requirement for increase population of the campus and seasonal variation in water availability, the committee recommended for additional buffer tank of capacity 200 kiloliter to be constructed adjacent to the new hostel (phase I).

The concreter approach road to hostel (phase I) is recommended to be constructed by CPWD only after completion of adjacent retaining wall. Immediately, for a short period an un-paved road may constructed.

The estimate for the above mentioned civil works are to be requested from CPWD.

Item No. 1.04: To consider new proposals for which estimates has been obtained

The BWC in principle approved for initial budget estimate in the tune of Rs 57897095 for serial no 1-7. Work orders are to be placed to CPWD after getting the detailed estimate. Further an iron entry gate at the existing entrance. A proper drainage facility for wastewater adjacent to hostel (phase I & II) are recommended.

Item No. 1.05: To consider

To consider new proposals for Multi-purpose complex, academic complex and new approach road with gate

The BWC noted the proposals subject to approval for adjacent land acquisition.

Item No. 1.06: To consider new proposals for separate dedicated power supply for NIT Sikkim campus

The Committee ratified the proposal and noted that estimate has been received from Energy and Power Department Sikkim.

Item No. 1.07: Any other matter with permission of the chair

No other business was proposed
