- 2. Applicants are advised to ensure, before appearing for Selection Process, that they possess the minimum essential qualification and experience laid down for the post. Qualification obtained has to be from a recognized University/Institute. Eligibility in terms of age, qualification, and experience of a candidate shall be considered as on the last date for receipt of application.
- 3. The relaxation on percentage/CGPA for the reserved candidates shall be given as per Government of India norm.
- 4. Candidates meeting minimum eligibility criteria shall not necessarily be called for interview. Criteria's can be set higher than the minimum requirement.
- 5. After joining the project, the person will have to abide by the Rules, Regulations, Ordinances, Statutes, and Acts of the Institute applicable from time-to-time. He/She may be assigned any duty within or outside the Institute, depending upon the exigency of the project work.
