



Amendments to Memorandum of Understanding Academic and Research Collaboration between National Institute of Technology, Sikkim, India and Indian Institute of Technology, Hyderabad, Telangana, India

National Institute of Technology, Sikkim (NITS) and Indian Institute of Technology, Hyderabad (IITH) have entered into Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) dated 19/06/2022. The following amendments are made to the said MoU:
