The following agenda items were discussed and decisions taken:









# Item No.16.01: To confirm the Minutes of the Meeting of the 15<sup>th</sup> Senate held on 26<sup>th</sup> March 2021.

The Minutes were circulated amongst the members, no comments were received. The minutes of the meeting of 15<sup>th</sup> Senate were unanimously confirmed by the house.

#### Item No.16.02: Academic Report & Action Taken Report.

The Senate noted the academic report and the action taken by the Institute. The Senate appreciated the efforts put in by the departments for timely completion of academic activities in this difficult time of pandemic.

# Item No.16.03: To consider and approve the recommendations of committees for effective implementation of NEP-2020.

The various committees were constituted in different thematic areas during the meeting of 15<sup>th</sup> Senate held on 26<sup>th</sup> March 2021 to study in-depth and to recommend the implementation policies/measures on the National Education Policy 2020 as envisaged by the Government of India. These committees consist of Prof. Lalit Kumar Awasthi, Director, NIT Jalandhar, Prof. R. K. Garg, NIT Jalandhar, Prof. Virendra Singh, IIT Bombay, Prof. Adrijit Goswami, IIT Kharagpur, Prof. Supriya Agarwal, Central University of Rajasthan, Mr. Dinesh Thawani, Celebal Technologies and internal members of the Institute. These committees have prepared an exhaustive strategic plan by refining the short-term and long-term goals for the implementation mechanism.

The Senate, after due deliberation, approved the recommendations of the committees, on the following thematic areas:

- (a) Academic Reforms.
- (b) Research and Development Activities.
- (c) Internationalization.
- (d) Promotion of Indian Language and Culture.
- (e) National Innovation and Start-up Policy.

The Senate appreciated the exhaustive exercise done by the committee members for drafting the Institute level strategic plans for implementation of the National Education Policy 2020 as envisaged by the Government of India. The Senate further directed the committees to prepare the road maps for the implementation mechanism. The committees are expected to finalize the above within one month so that some of them can be implemented from the academic session 2021-22. Furthermore, the Senate advised that the committees entrusted with task of implementation of various objectives of NEP 2020 will explore the signing of MoU with National and International institutions and arrange to sign the MoUs in phased manner. The HSS Department may begin with signing the MoU with University of Delhi.



Item No.16.04: To consider and approve the recommendations of the empowered committee on additional special eligibility criteria for admission in M. Sc. Chemistry program through CCMN/ IAT.

The Senate approved the recommendations of the committee for eligibility criteria for admission to M.Sc. Chemistry program at NIT Sikkim through CCMN/ IAT (Institutional Admission Test). The given criteria shall be effective from academic session 2021-22:

"B.Sc. degree (3 years / 4 years) with Chemistry as the main subject in at least six (06) semesters."

Item No.16.05: To consider and approve the semester registration and teaching-learning process for Odd semester 2021-22.

The Senate deliberated and approved the registration and teaching-learning process to be adopted for odd semester 2021-22 for <u>UG</u>, <u>PG</u> and <u>Ph.D.</u> program. The senate also approved that – (i) the hostel fee shall be waived off fully, if students are not residing in the hostel. (ii) If students are called to attend the classes and reside in the hostel, the hostel fee shall be charged proportionately, (iii) the Institute fee shall be charged as applicable, (iv) the tentative academic calendar for odd semester 21-22 is approved and attached at **Annexure-I.** 

Item No.16.06: To consider and approve the seat matrices for B.Tech., M. Tech. and M.Sc. programs for 2021-22.

The Senate approved seat matrix for admission in B. Tech. (both with and without EWS), M. Tech. and M.Sc. programs for 2021-22. The seat matrices for B.Tech. programs shall be applicable as per directions of the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India. The Senate asked the Dean Academic to remind the Ministry of Education regarding the matter and decision. The seat matrices are placed at **Annexure-II.** 

The Senate also asked the Dean Academic to remind the Ministry of Defence/Concerned Department, Govt. of India regarding the availability of supernumerary seats reserved for direct admission to Defence Officers in the M.Tech. Program.

Item No.16.07: To consider and approve the advertisement for Ph.D. admission in Odd semester 2021-22.

The agenda was approved as proposed. The advertisement for the admission to Ph.D. program for the odd semester 2021-22 in various departments shall be published as per the amended rules and regulations of Ph.D. program.
