Item No.23.06: To discuss and decide the course of action for the Ph. D. students admitted at the Institute with fellowship/scholarship and leaving before the completion of the program.

The Senate deliberated and decided that selected Ph.D. students with Institute fellowship/scholarship who wish to withdraw before the completion of Ph.D program have to return all the fellowship/scholarship they have withdrawan during the period of Ph.D. Otherwise, the caution money will be forfeited and the clearance will not be given.

Item No.23.07:To consider and approve the minimum pass marks of 35% in the End-Term Examination (ETE) for theory subjects and practicals/sessionals of UG and PG programs.

The Senate deliberated and approved that a student must score a minimum of 35% marks in the End-Term Examination (ETE) in theory subjects and practicals/sessionals individually to pass the subject. This will improve the quality of education and the teaching-learning process. It will be effective from Even Semester 2022-23 onwards for all the programs of the Institute. The UG and PG rules and regulations shall be amended accordingly.

Item No.23.08:To consider and approve the amendment of Rule 7 of the existing Ph.D. rules and regulations to allow "Part-time Ph.D. Candidates admitted under clause 3.2.2.ii" to complete their Ph.D. course work through online/guided study mode.

The Senate deliberated and approved the inclusion of the following clause under Rule 7 of the Rules & Regulations for the Programs of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) 2019:

Rule 7.7 (v): "In case of part-time external candidates with at least 5 years of research experience in R&D Organizations, with the special permission of the DGC and approval of the senate, the residential requirement may be waived-off. Nevertheless, it is mandatory for such candidates to complete the course work for the prescribed number of credits through online/ guided study mode. Other requirements, like assignments, examinations etc., will remain same as prescribed for any regular course or as decided by the DGC."

Item No. 23.09:To consider and approve the extension of the registration period of research scholars beyond seven years (5 years + 2 years extension).

The Senate granted the three (03) months extension beyond seven years of the registration period to Mr. Keshab Das considering the progress of the candidate. It is recommended by the DGC, DPGC and SPGB. His registration will be valid till 31.05.2023.

Item No. 23.10: To consider and approve the cancellation of registration Mr. Rahul Deo Verma for not submitting his thesis within seven years (5 years + 2 years extension) of the registration period.

The Institute has not received any communication from the DGC or DPGC regarding further extension of the registration period. As per the rules, if a research scholar fails to submit her/his Ph.D. thesis on completion of SEVEN years, her/his registration from the Ph.D. program shall stand cancelled.

He has completed Seven (07) years after the initial registration and even the pre-synopsis seminar to submit the thesis has not been conducted. Therefore, the Senate approved the cancellation of the registration of Mr. Rahul Deo Verma, Department of Computer Science and Engineering.

Item No. 23.11: To consider and approve the cancellation of registration Ms. Jayati Routh as per the clause 11.5.(ii) of the Ph. D. Rules and Regulations of the Institute.
