Item No. 4.3: To consider the Four Year B Tech course curricula and syllabus modified in the curriculaworkshop held at IIT KGP Extension Centre on 26th& 27th Aug. 2016 and to implement it from Academic session 2017-18.

The Institute has conducted curricula development workshop during 26th and 27th August2016 at IIT KGP Extension Centre to frame up the Four year B. Tech course curricula and syllabus in consultation with the subject expert from IITs, IISER, IIEST etc. The proposed syllabus has been put up to the Senate for consideration and approval after due discussion. The Senate approves the course curricula and syllabus with minor modification. The new course curriculum and syllabus may be implemented from 2017-18 B Tech admission. The Senate suggest to conduct a curriculum development workshop for Basic Sciences and Humanities to finalize the syllabus as well.

Item No. 4.4: To consider the Two Year M Tech course curricula and syllabus modified in the curricula workshop held at IIT KGP Extension Centre on 26th & 27th Aug2016 for Computer Science & Engineering (CSE) and Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE) and to implement it from academic session 2017-18.

The Institute has conducted curriculum development workshop to frame up the two year M. Techcourse curricula and syllabus in consultation with the subject expert from IITs, IISER, IIEST etc. The proposed course curricula and syllabus have been put up to the Senate for

consideration and approval. The Senate approves the course curricula and syllabus with minor modification. The new course curriculum and syllabus may be implemented from 2017-18 M Tech admission.

Item No. 4.5: To consider starting M Tech programme in Electrical and Electronics Engineering Department from the Session 2017-18.

Proposal for starting two year full time M Tech programme in Electrical Engineering with specialisation in Control, Power and Electric Drivesfrom academic session 2017-18 has been approved by the Senate. Initial intake may be 15 (6GN+2SC+1ST+3OBC+3 Sponsored candidates).

The course curricula and syllabus for the proposed M Tech programme have been developed in consultation with the subject expertin curricula development workshop and placed for consideration of the Senate. The Senate approves the course curricula and syllabus with some modification.

Item No. 4.6: To consider the amendment/inclusion/deletion B Tech and PhD rules and regulations under specific clauses.

The proposals for amendment of B Tech & PhD rules recommended by the Committee have been placed for discussion in the Senate. After deliberations the Senate approves the same with some modifications.

Item No. 4.7: To discuss on the arrangement of first Convocation.

i. Proposed dates

The Institute proposes to hold its first convocation in the 2nd or 3rd week of March 2017 for the passed out batches 2010- 14, 2011-2015 and 2012-2016. The Senate approves the same.

ii. Stock of arrangement for convocation

The detailed syllabus for 'Research Methodology in Science & Technology' and Research Methodology in Humanities (4 credit) for all PhD students are placed and approved by the Senate.

Item No. 4.10: To consider minor modification in B Tech course structure

The Senate approves the modifications in B Tech course structure for Civil and Mechanical Engineering department.

Item No. 4.11: To discuss the issue of conversion of Full Time PhD to Part Time

The Senate approves the application of Mr Ujjal Kumar Das forconversion of full time PhD to part time PhD to enable him to join in the regular position of Technical Assistant post at NIT Sikkim.

Item No. 4.12:To discuss about the signatory in the Mark sheet and Degree certificate

The Controller in-charge (Examination)will be the signatory for semester resultsand the Director NIT Sikkim will be the signatory for final degree certificate. Both have been nominated by the Senate.

GIAN

The proposal to send B.Tech., M.Tech., PhD students and faculty members of the Institute to GIAN courses organized in premier educational institutes in the country are discussed in the Senate. 1. To introduction of M Sc programme in Chemistry from the Session 2017-18.

The introduction of M Sc programme in Chemistry with intake capacity 15 has been discussed, considered and approved by the Senate. The Senate also feels that it is not possible at the present moment to provide space to the department. The department may consider the option of recruitment of visiting faculty members. Further it is also proposed that MSc in other science departments may be started in subsequent sessions.
