# Item No.7.8: To consider and approve the incorporation of NPTEL/MOOC/SWAYAM courses in the curriculum of UG and PG courses as audit and/orcredit courses at NIT Sikkim.

The Senate deliberated and approved in principal for adoption of various good quality online courses through online platforms like NPTEL/MOOC/SWAYAM to facilitate the students. It was decided to consider online courses available through this platform as audit and/ or credit course for various disciplines in the institute. The Senate constituted the following committee to work out the frame work of credit and detail evaluation process, etc. for flawless implementation of this scheme.

- a) Dean Academic Affairs as Chairman
- b) All Heads of the. Department-members
- c) Two experts from CFTIs

The recommendation of committee shall be placed in the next senate meeting.

## Item No.7.9: To consider and approve the issue of registration of existing Interdisciplinary PhD research scholars.

The Institute has enrolled following two PhD scholar in interdisciplinary area. The Senate deliberated on the issue of their registration and following decision were taken:

- a) Mr. Arabinda Gosh (Enrolment number: PHID160023) will register in the Electrical and Electronics Department.
- b) Mr. Swapan Manna (Enrolment Number: PHID150002) will register in the HSS department and has to complete one more course in library science through online/self-study mode. One external supervisor of same field is to be engaged. The chairman Senate was authorised to take decision in this regard.

### Item No.7.10: To constitute the committee for revision of UG, PG and PhD rules and regulations.

A need for revision in the above rules and regulations is necessary to resolve many issues and give right direction to this new Institute. The Senate constituted the following committees to revise the existing rules and regulations for under graduate, post graduate and Ph.D program of the institute.

- Déan Academic Affairs as chairman for all the committees
- Three members from the Institute
- Three external members from other IITs/NITs.

The committee shall study the existing rules and regulations of some of the reputed institutes like IITs and NITs and prepare the ordinance, rules and regulations and place in the next senate for the approval. The chairman senate is authorised to nominate the members on above committee.

### Item No.7.11: To consider and approve two Mid-term examinations for UG and PG courses from academic session 2018-19.

### Item No.7.13: To consider and approve the amendment in UG, PG & PhD rules & Regulation.

The Senate approved the recommendations for the amendment in the following clauses of existing rules and regulations for UG, PG and PhD with minor modification.

- a) Medical Leave rules for B. Tech., M. Tech. MSc. and PhD.
- b) Evaluation- Grading system for B. Tech., and M. Tech.
- c) Promotion rule for B. Tech rules and regulations.

### Item No.7.14: To consider and approve the increase of B Tech seat in CSE department.

The Senate accorded the approval for increase in B. Tech. seats in the Computer Science & Engineering program from existing 45 seats to 60 seats from academic session 2018-19.

### Item No.7.15: To consider and approve the revised fee structure of UG, PG and PhD courses.

The Senate considered and approved the revision in fee structure of UG, PG and PhD courses. The revisions are given below. This will be made effective from the session 2018-19 for all years.

#### To consider the issue of supplementary examination for B. Tech. first year Item No.7.17: students.

Student are allowed to appear in supplementary examination after each semester on the payment of Rs.1000/- per subject. The remedial classes may be held for such students in vacations as decided by the concerned department. Normally, they will be given three chances for appearing supplementary examination in any subject as per the academic calendar. Any special chance if needed shall be given on the recommendation of the standing committee of the senate and approval of the chairman senate on the payment of Rs.2500/- per subject. Such students have to stay in the campus in the vacation and special remedial classed will be held for them. This shall be effective for all the students of B.Tech courses.

## Item No.7.19: To consider and approve the issue of backlog subjects of B. Tech. first year students admitted in 2016-17 session.

The NIT Sikkim has started the new syllabus for the B Tech students admitted in 2017-18 session. But some of the students who took admission in 2016-17 session were not promoted to second year. Those students may clear their backlog subjects as per the old syllabus and will be allowed to complete their B Tech program from second year onwards as per new syllabus.

The Senate approved the same in principal, however the Senate Chairman is empowered take decision in this regard.

## Item No.7.20: To consider and approve the Registration Number of M.Sc. Chemistry students.

NIT Sikkim is following 10 digit registration number for B.Tech, M. Tech and PhD students where first four digits represents the year of admission, next two digit represents the code for the program (01 for B.Tech, 02 for M.Tech and 05 for PhD) and the last four digit represents the last four digit of their enrolment number. From 2017-18 sessions NIT Sikkim had started Two year M.Sc program in Chemistry. The code for M.Sc program is assigned as 03.

### Item No.7.21: To consider and approve the Teaching / Research Assistantship from TEQIP-III to MSc and PhD students.

The Senate approved the Teaching and Research assistantship of Rs.10000/-month for PhD scholar and Rs.7000/- month for M. Sc./M. Tech. students who are not receiving any assistantship from the Government or any other organisation can be provided assistantship from TEQIP-III.

The same shall be made effective from the session 2018-19.

#### Item No.7.22: To consider and approve the academic calendar 2018-19 academic session.

The summary of academic calendar for 2018-19 was noted and approved by the Senate. The detail academic calendar for 2018-19 shall be put up in the next senate for approval. However, Standing Committee of the Senate and chairman senate was authorised to change the same, if need arises. The same shall be reported to the senate in its next meeting for ratification.

#### Item No.7.23: To consider and approve the contingency fund for M Tech Students.

The Senate approved in principal the contingency grant of Rs.5000/- per annum for GATE qualified M.Tech. Students under Post Graduate Scholarship scheme of UGC. The same can only be payable subject to the availability of fund from MHRD under this head.

#### Item No.7.24: To consider and approve the closure of Biotechnology branch.

The senate was appraised that the Biotechnology branch was opened from 2015-16 academic session with 30 seats of intake capacity. The students' intake in 2015-19, 2016-20 & 2017-2021 batch was seven (7), four (4) and sixteen (16) respectively. However, four (4) students of 2016-2020 batches have changed their branch with the approval of 6<sup>th</sup> Senate. Further, the student of 2015-19 batches has requested several time for shifting to other established institutions or change their branch.

The institute is running in temporary location and have acute shortage of space and therefore unable to provide even basic facilities like laboratory etc.

The 16 (Sixteen) Students admitted in the academic session 2017-2018 has also submitted their representation for branch change.

The Senate deliberated in details on the related issues and decided for closer of Biotechnology branch from 2018-19 academic session and the 16 (Sixteen) students presently in first year shall be shifted to other engineering branches. As advised by the senate, the possibilities to transfer third year students to other Institutes/industries for study or otherwise will also be explored. A committee will be constituted for the same by the chairman senate to explore the possible solutions in the benefit of the students. The chairman senate was authorised to take the decision in this regard.

### Item No. 7.25: To consider and approve the remedial classes for academically weak students.

The main purpose of this program is to groom the overall personality of the students and make them acquainted with the culture/environment of the institution.

Item No.7.30.2: To discuss on the revision of fee notification of MHRD vide: F.No.33-4/2014 - TS-III, Dated: 24<sup>th</sup> June 2016 and 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2016.

In line to the MHRD notification vide F.no.33-4/2014-TS.III dated 24<sup>th</sup>June 2016 and 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2106 based on the decision of the Council of NITs, B.Tech. students who are economically backward and can avail the benefits of fee remission. The following procedure will be adopted.

The Senate has decided that the academic section should notify the students in prior in each odd semester for submission of following documents for claiming fee remission:

- Annual parental/family income proof issued by competent authority of respective states (Income certificate, Salary statement in case of govt. employee, TDS return for business personnel), and
- Affidavit declaring the gross annual income of all family members from all sources under the notary seal.
