Item No. C01.01: To consider and approve the admission criteria for ICCR sponsored candidates in the UG and PG program.

The Senate approved the admission criteria for ICCR sponsored candidates in the UG & PG program in principle.

In order to make the equal representation of candidates across the participating countries, the following criteria shall be adopted while allotting the seats in UG and PG programs for the ICCR sponsored candidates:

Rose A

- a) The country wise ranking based on their grading system will be prepared.
- b) The seats shall allocated in rotation amongst the countries. The efforts shall be made to allot the equal number of seats to each country.
- c) If, the eligible candidates are not available in some branch, the seats will be filled with eligible available candidates on merit basis.

Further to it, the eligible criteria for shortlisting the applications and guidelines for UG and PG programs as approved by the Senate in its 17th meeting vide agenda item no 17.03 shall continue to remain in force. The same is placed at **Annexure-I**.

Eligibility Criteria and Important Guidelines for Admission through ICCR for B.Tech., M.Tech., M. Sc. and Ph.D. programs

Eligibility Criteria

a. B. Tech. Programs

- (1) The candidate should have minimum 75% aggregate or 8.0/10.0 CGPA with Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and English, in XIIth or equivalent examination.
- (2) The year of passing in qualifying examination should be the year of admission or previous two years, i.e. if the candidate is applying for admission in academic session 2021-22, then the year of passing in qualifying examination shall be 2021, 2020 or 2019.
- (3) In case, the merit can not be decided by criteria (1), the marks/ grade of the following subjects will be considered in order as tie-breaker:
- (i) Mathematics
- (ii) Physics

- (iii) Chemistry
- (iv) English

Even after applying the above criteria, if the merit is not decided, then the date of birth of the candidate will be considered i.e. candidate born earlier shall be given priority over other.

b. M. Tech./ M. Sc. Programs

1. As per prevalent Institute rules and regulations for the M. Tech./ M.Sc. Programs.

c. Ph.D. Programs

1. As per prevalent Institute rules and regulations for the Ph.D. Programs.

The Departments of the Institute may independently set higher criteria for the selection of the candidates in any or all of the programs. The decision of the Institute/ Committee shall be final and binding on all concerned.

Important Guidelines

- The candidate should not be a citizen of India.
- The candidate should have valid passport for the entire duration of the allotted program.
- Branch once allotted, will not be changed.
- The admission will be considered as supernumerary quota.
- The candidate should join the Institute as per the registration schedule.
- The Institute reserves the right to offer admission to eligible candidates.
- The Institute may deny admission to any or all of the candidates if necessary, without assigning any reason thereof.
- The admitted students have to abide by the directions/ rules/ regulations of the Institute, MoE and the concerned Ministries of GoI issued from time to time.
