M.Sc in Applied Artificial Intelligence delivered in Online Mode

Program Structure

- The M.Sc. in Applied Artificial Intelligence by NIT Sikkim is a two-year program consisting of **4 semesters**.
- Classes are delivered online on weekends (Saturday & Sunday) by NIT Sikkim faculty and Industry Experts.
- Provision for a certificate (but not a degree) without a thesis is available.
- If a candidate is unable to complete course requirements, an additional 1 year will be provided to clear the backlogs.

Governing Committee

A governing committee consisting of NIT Sikkim faculty and industry experts has been constituted to ensure compliance of the courses with NIT Sikkim academic standards. This committee reports to the NIT Sikkim Senate at regular intervals.

Eligibility Criteria

- Graduates with an education qualification of a minimum (12 + 3 years) like B.Sc.,
 B.Com, or equivalent degree.
- Min. 55% percentage or 6 CGPI for candidates.
- Candidates should have mathematics in their graduation or in 12th class.
 If the candidate does not have mathematics as a subject, then an additional course will be provided and must be cleared in order to obtain the degree.

Enrolment Criterion

Shortlisted candidates must clear a written exam test.

Admission Process

- 8. All applications will be reviewed by NIT Sikkim, and if an application is not found to be prima facie meeting the required criterion, then NIT Sikkim will ask Intellipat to reject the application.
- 9. Intellipaat will communicate to the eligible candidates the date for the online proctored written test and interview after verification of documents. The written test will be conducted at regular intervals.
- 10. Selection of a candidate will be done on the basis of his academic credentials, experience, and performance in the written test.
- 11. The list of selected candidates will be shared by NIT Sikkim with Intellipaat, and also confirmation email will be sent to selected candidates by NIT Sikkim. All those who are not selected will be refunded the full application fee.
- 12. Offer letters for selected candidates will be sent by NIT Sikkim through email and posted to candidates with copies to Intellipaat.
- 13. Intellipaat will initiate the collection of the balance fee from the candidate after the offer letter has been sent by NIT Sikkim.
