
### Sub: Invitation for Quotations for supply of Goods

5. Quotation shall remain valid for a period not less than **30** days after the last date of quotation submission.

6.2 Confirm to the terms and conditions, and specifications.

7. The Quotations would be evaluated for all items together.

8. Award of contract:

The Purchaser will award the contract to the bidder whose quotation has been determined to be substantially responsive and who has offered the lowest evaluated quotation price.

8.1 Notwithstanding the above, the Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any quotations and to cancel the bidding process and reject all quotations at any time prior to the award of contract.



**Satisfactory Acceptance - 10% of total cost**


10. All supplied items are under warranty of **24** months from the date of successful acceptance of items.



1	-80°C refrigeration	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The instrument cabinet should be upright and single door with approximately 380L capacity</li><li>2. Polyurethane insulation with 5.0" foamed-in-place should be present in the instrument</li><li>3. Two access port (1") for inexpedient probes should be present in the system</li><li>4. Dust protection of the instrument condenser by washable and easy removable filter is highly preferred</li><li>5. Single handed instrument operation by ergonomic door handle, lock and key facility and padlock compatible should be present in the instrument</li><li>6. Adjustable temperature range of the instrument should be -75°C to -</li></ol>




