- a) Whether 22 posts of faculty out of sanctioned posts of 53 are lying vacant in Indian Institute of Information Technology (IIIT), Sri City, Chittoor;

Reply: N.A.

- b) If so, whether the Government is managing these vacancies of faculty through part-time or contract or re-employment of teachers and if so, the details thereof;

Reply: N.A.

- c) Whether the above vacancies are due to enhancement of students' strength and if so, the details thereof;

Reply: N.A.

- d) whether the Government has directed all Central Higher Educational Institutions to fill up the vacancies in a Mission Mode within a period of one year starting from September, 2021; and

Reply: Yes, director from MoE to fill up the vacancies in a mission mode from September, 2021 has been received by NIT Sikkim.

- e) if so, the details thereof along with the status of filling up of the said 22 vacancies?

Reply: Despite initiating the recruitment drive to fill up the vacancies in September 2021, the Institute could not complete the recruitment drive. The status of the same is appended below: -

1. Recruitment drive to fill twelve (12) vacancies was initiated in September 2021.
2. Shortlisting procedure was completed duly following the procedure laid down in the regular faculty recruitment rule of NITs.
3. Final selection process (interview) could not be arranged due to the unavailability of the list of visitor's Nominee for the formation of the Selection Committee.
4. The list, which expired in August 2021, was finally reintroduced in April 2022 by the MoE.
5. The term of the present Director was up to 30th April 2022. His term was extended for two more months but the permission to conduct the Interview was denied by the Ministry.
6. Recently, the term of the Director has been extended further up to 31st December 2022 or the joining of New Director, whichever is earlier.

7. Joint Secretary, NITs has verbally asked the Institute no to conduct the Interview.

Under these circumstances the Institute will not be able to comply with the ministry directives regarding the filling up of vacancies.

Response on Lok Sabha Unstarred Question No. 4033 for 28.03.2022 regarding Medium of Instruction in Higher/Technical Education.

- (a) Whether the medium of instruction of medical, engineering and other courses for graduation/post-graduation is English medium only and if so, the details thereof;

Ans. Medium of Instruction at NIT Sikkim is in English since course of engineering is difficult to manage in Hindi due to non-availability bi-lingual faculty and books.

- (b) Whether the material of these courses of higher education is available in Hindi medium and if so, the details thereof;

Ans. NO

- (c) Whether a large number of students of Hindi medium and students from rural areas are deprived of these technical and other courses of higher education due to English medium of instruction as they face difficulties in reading, understanding and writing their subjects in English and if so, the details thereof;

Ans. Some of the students face problem as they come from rural areas. Institute takes initiative to teach them separately to make them comfortable in reading, understanding and writing their subjects in english. But, majority of the students enrolled are from English background of teaching and learning.

- (d) The details of courses of higher education where medium of instruction is both in Hindi and English along with the details of such courses where the Government is considering to introduce medium of instruction as Hindi along with English; and

Ans. Not as now, however Institute is working to make bi-lingual in some of the basic courses.

- (e) The steps taken or proposed to be taken by the Government to make necessary arrangements for study of various courses of technical and higher education through Hindi medium,

Ans. Under NEP 2020, Institute is planning to introduce some of the courses in Hindi and other languages in due course of time.

Reply: Yes, and as per the direction of the Ministry, NIT Sikkim has been striving to fill the vacant posts of the Institute.

In this regard, the Institute has been able to fill 36 (Thirty-Six) Non-Teaching posts out of 37 (Thirty-Seven) sanctioned posts in the Institute. The recruitment process for teaching post was initiated in 2021 and the applications were received and duly shortlisted; however, the final selection process could not be completed due to the non-availability of the visitor's nominee and completion of the term of the incumbent director. Also, as the new Visitor's nominee was nominated the term of the director was about to end as his tenure was only extended for two months; therefore, the recruitment process could not be undertaken. However; as of now the term of the director has been further extended till 31st December 2022 and a new Visitors Nominee has been nominated but the Ministry has verbally advised not to continue the recruitment process as of date.

NIT Sikkim has constantly done better in placement. The percentage of placement for the batch 2018 is 56% and 2019 batch is 63%.

NIT Sikkim has slightly improved the ranking though the Institute is yet to make it in the top 100 Institutions. Because of the following constraints like inadequate faculty strength, allotment of permanent campus, insufficient basic infrastructure for students and faculty, lack of lab facilities etc.

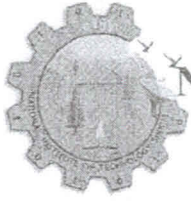

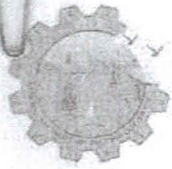

5. **Research & Development:** Due to temporary campus the research facilities are highly limited, however, the Institute is presently offering PhD courses in all discipline.

6. **Permanent campus:** NIT Sikkim is waiting for the allotment of permanent campus since 08 years. NIT Sikkim has not been able to expand its capacity due to non availability of permanent land. Lack of desired infrastructure has been the major cause for inadequate facilities and support to the students and faculty, leading to poor quality of education and dissatisfied students and faculty. The constraint of space limits the expansion of the capacity and also prohibits the exploitation of the full potential of an Institute of national importance like NIT. Even the basic lab facilities are missing.

The matter may be taken up to the senior level for the allotment of permanent campus.

Since the Institute is still in its formative stage, it is not possible to make this Institute self sufficient unless we have permanent campus at good location. Therefore, dependent on central Government funds.

Presently, there is no ERP/MIS System in the Institute. A comprehensive ERP/MIS system is required for the smooth functioning of the academic, financial and administrative works of the Institute. The initiative will be taken with the permission of FC & BoG.

The recruitment is carried out strictly as per the MHRD guidelines for faculty and staff through in house Process.

1. **Administrative:** Board of Governors and Finance Committee are there to monitor the administrative matters.
2. **Civil & Electrical Work:** Buildings and Works Committee is there to monitor and advice for the Civil and Electrical work.
3. **Academic:** Senate monitors and advices for all the academic matters.

Apart from this various committees are formed from time to time to monitor and execute the various administrative and academic works.

1. Allotment of land for permanent campus needs utmost attention at MHRD level.
2. Sanction adequate number of faculty positions (46 additional faculty positions required to be sanctioned).
