1. Please provide details of sanctioned, in-position, and vacant posts of Professors, Assistant Professors and Associate Professors are vacant in IITs, IIMs, IISERs, Central universities and other higher educational institutions? Please also provide details as to since when the posts have been vacant?

2. Please provide details of steps being taken by the department to fill the vacant posts in higher educational institutions and by when the vacancies are likely to be fulfilled?

NIT Sikkim has carried out two recruitment drives and recruited faculty members. The first recruitment-drive was carried out in 2016 and the second recruitment drive was carried out in 2018-2019. All the Assistant professors posts were filled. However, no suitable candidate was found against the posts of Professor and Associate Professor. Non-availability of proper infrastructure, housing facilities, medical infrastructure etc., at the remote temporary campus of the Institute have made it difficult to attract candidates for Professor & Associate Professor positions. Further, the Institute has requested the ministry to sanction 42 additional faculty positions as per the prescribed students-teacher ratio of 12:1. The Institute is going to initiate the next recruitment drive as and when the additional posts will be sanctioned.

3. Please provide details of initiatives taken by the department and other regulatory authorities to attract students to pursue research? How many PhD students are currently enrolled in all the higher educational institutions?

Jaman

The Institute takes all possible measures to attract students to pursue research. The PhD admission process is carried out twice a year. At present total 57 number of research scholars are doing PhD research at the Institute. The stipend, Library, hostel facilities are provided to the scholars. The scholars are given academic freedom to attend and interact with the academic fraternity to enhance collaborative research. The faculty supervisors are working very hard to support good research output and mentor them constantly.

4. What is the number of women faculty members (also in terms of percentage of total posts) in IITs, IIMs, IISERs, Central universities and other higher educational institutions? What are the steps taken to increase their share in various faculty positions?

At present there are 02 (two) women faculty members against the total sanctioned post of 38. The percentage, therefore, is 5%. The Institute guarantees the implementation of woman-centered schemes of the Ministry and ensures an academically healthy, safe and vibrant atmosphere for all faculty members without any gender discrimination. However, non-availability of proper infrastructure, housing facilities, medical infrastructure etc., at this remote temporary campus of the Institute have made it difficult to attract women candidates.

5. What are the reasons for faculty shortage at many of the new central universities or the new IITs/IIMs/NITs? What steps are being taken by the Department to attract faculty in these higher educational institutions?

Institute is waiting for sanctioning of required faculty positions from the ministry. The saction of additional required faculty positions is necessary for such remotely located NIT, as filling of professor and associate professor posts is very difficult due to the remote location, temporary campus, harsh climatic conditions, lack of basic amenities and facilities including essential medical facilities, lack of city life etc.

6. Please provide details of initiatives taken by the Department, UGC and higher educational institutions to attract foreign faculty and Indian researchers from abroad?

The recruitment is done as per the recruitment rule of NITs.

7. Many of the Universities in the country are having a large number of ad-hoc faculty. How is it affecting the quality of education being imparted and what steps are being taken by the institutions/universities to make these faculty permanent after a certain years of teaching experience?

Engagement of ad-hoc/temporary faculty becomes necessary to teach in classes due to shortage of regular faculty. Although it affects the quality of teaching to some extent as continuity/retaining of such faculty cannot be ensured. The recruitment can be done as per the rules provided by the ministry and the temporary faculty can also apply.

8. What policy is being undertaken by the department to increase the share of SC/ST/minorities and differently-abled in the faculty in higher educational institutions?

The Institute guarantees the implementation of SC/ST/ minorities and PH centered schemes of the Ministry. The reservation roaster is strictly maintained and observed in recruitment and all possible/available benefits are provided to the employees of the mentioned categories. The Institute also ensures an academically healthy, safe and vibrant atmosphere for all faculty members without any discrimination.

9. Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT) aims to build a strong professional cadre of teachers by addressing all the issues related to teachers, teaching, teacher preparation, professional development, curriculum design, design and development of more effective pedagogy and better assessment and evaluation methodologies. What is the current progress under this scheme? Please provide details.

The Institute always implement all the scheme of the government, however, no application has been received till date under this scheme.

10. Please provide details of initiatives being taken by the department and other regulatory bodies in making the courses relevant and significant to the students as all as to the nation as a whole?

The Institute constantly interacts with people from Industry and take their feedback to keep the curriculum updated. The Institute regularly organizes curriculum development workshops by involving all the stake holders. The curriculum is regularly updated as per the requirements of the industry. The Institute is very dynamic in adopting new technologies/new courses to make the students industry ready and do research on cutting edge technologies.

11. Whether any assessment has been made as to how the COVID-2019 pandemic has impacted the higher education system in the country? Please provide details thereof.

The indirect assessment has been made by the Institute. Being a technical institution the requirement of theoretical subjects is fulfilled in online mode, however, this impacts practical learning and hands on experience in the laboratories. The Institute is constantly devising the mechanism/methods to teach the students in the most convenient way by taking regular feedback, mentoring, counselling (mental as well as academic). We also found that conducting online classes from Ravangla is difficult due to poor Internet facility, the same problem was also faced by the students staying at remote locations. However, the Institute is also trying to find a hybrid method to address the problems of academically weak students or having poor internet connectivity by calling them to campus.

12. Please provide details of both short-term and long-term measures contemplated to mitigate the situation arisen out of the pandemic.

Short Term Measures: Institute has proposed to start online theory classes for all the courses from August 2020. The online evaluation mechanism is also evolved. The teaching material shall be provided to all the students. Students wise faculty mentors have been assigned by each departments. Committees at the department level are also created to address the grievances/problems of the students. The students are encouraged to talk to faculty on mobile as and when they need. The faculty also remain in touch with the students at department level. Special care is taken for academically weak students. All the students have been promoted to the next semester irrespective of their backlogs. The laboratory courses which cannot completed online due to certain academic requirements shall be completed as and when the students return to the campus.

Long Term Goals: Enhancement of IT infrastructure to provide online teaching learning environment. Facilitate faculty and staff to cater the need of online teaching learning requirements. Allow students for online courses and facilitate with credit transfer. Necessary efforts shall be made to provide internship/practical training in the industry and arrange placements for the students in the difficult time.

- Efforts are being made to hire a consultant for the students to look after the psychological and other issues. The matter has already been approved by the Board of Governors. The process of recruitment is to be initiated.
